POWER PROFILER: VADM JEROME M. ADAMS, M.D., M.P.H.



Vice Admiral (VADM) Jerome M. Adams, M.D., M.P.H. is the 20th Surgeon General of the United States. His mission as the "Nation's Doctor," is to advance the health of the American people, and his motto is "better health through better partnerships." He is committed to forging new partnerships and strengthening existing relationships with members from the business, faith, education, and public safety and national security communities.

As the Surgeon General, Dr. Adams holds the rank of Vice Admiral in the U.S. Public Health Service (USPHS) Commissioned Corps. In this capacity, he oversees the operations of more than 6,000 uniformed health officers who serve in nearly 800 locations around the world, promoting, protecting, and advancing the health and safety of our nation.

During his tenure, Dr. Adams has created several initiatives to tackle our nation's most pressing health issues, including: the opioid epidemic, oral health,

and the links between community health and both economic prosperity and national security. He is also a member of the President's Coronavirus Task Force.

Dr. Adams is focused on building a culture of health and prevention in all sectors, and as part of those efforts, he is compiling a report of available evidence and best practices documenting the connection between private sector investments and public policies. These connections promote healthy communities, and subsequent measures of business and community prosperity. The report will share the evidence, inspire future research and provide tools and resources for effective, efficient community health investments that produce results.

Dr. Adams received bachelor's degrees in both biochemistry and psychology from the University of Maryland, Baltimore County, a master of public health degree from the University of California at Berkeley, and a medical degree from Indiana University
